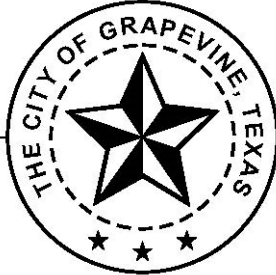
2. Receive a report and hold a discussion regarding the City Council and Planning and Zoning Commission's roles and responsibilities relative to land use decisions.

6. Receive a report, hold a discussion, and provide staff direction regarding expansion of historic landmark overlays to non-residential buildings and properties within the Historic Grapevine Township District (HGT) and establish demolition standards for Historic Township District and landmarked properties.
