GRAPEVINE, Texas - Speed appears to be a factor in a deadly rollover crash today on SH-121.

Witnesses say just before 3:00 p.m., the driver of a red Corvette travelling north on SH-121 tried to merge with another lane and lost control. The car swerved across the highway before striking a barrier wall and going airborne. The car flew over the median, and landed in the southbound lanes of SH-121. The driver was pronounced dead at the scene.

Debris from the vehicle hit two other cars on SH-121, but nobody else was hurt. Officers closed SH-121 at William D. Tate for about an hour in both directions, as well as northbound SH-360. Both highways have reopened.

The identity of the victim is not being released pending notification to next of kin. The crash remains under investigation.
